

4. The payment of arrears of Dearness Relief shall not to be made before the date of disbursement of Pension/Family pension of October, 2024.

5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in Rule 52 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 2021 and this Department's O.M. No. 45/73/97-P&PW(G) dated 2-7-1999 as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

8. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA,II/34-80-II dated 23-04-1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

9. In so far as the persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller and

Auditor General of India, as mandated under Article 148 (5) of the Constitution of India.

10. This issues in accordance with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's O. M. No. 1/5/2024-E-II(B) dated 21-10-2024 and approval of C&AG.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 18 of the Goa Staff Selection Commission Act, 2019 (Goa Act 11 of 2019) and with the approval of the Government, the Goa Staff Selection Commission hereby makes the following regulations, so as to further amend the Goa Staff Selection Commission (Examinations, Selection of candidates to the sub-ordinate services/posts and procedure for conduct of the business of the Commission) Regulations, 2023, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These regulations may be called the Goa Staff Selection Commission (Examinations, Selection of candidates to the sub-ordinate services/posts and Procedure for conduct of the business of the Commission) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of regulation 4.*— In regulation 4 of the Goa Staff Selection Commission (Examinations, Selection of candidates to the sub-ordinate services/posts and procedure for conduct of the business of the Commission) Regulations, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations"),

for clause (3), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(3) The vacancies to be intimated to the Commission shall be clear vacancies and shall not include anticipated vacancies.”.

3. *Amendment of regulation 5.*— In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations, for clause (9), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(9) The Commission may direct the candidate to upload such documents as may be required during online submission of application form. Non-submission of documents or submission of incorrect or false document/s shall be a ground for rejection of application without any notice.”.

4. *Amendment of regulation 10.*— In regulation 10 of the principal Regulations, in clause (4), for the expression “minimum 2 invigilators”, the expression “minimum 1 invigilator” shall be substituted.

5. *Amendment of regulation 11.*— In regulation 11 of the principal Regulations, for clause (2), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(2) In respect of posts requiring skill test as essential qualification, the Commission shall either itself, or through any Department or any agency or a committee of such officers as may be constituted by it, conduct a skill test. The Commission may decide the sequence of conducting skill test and the decision of the Commission shall be final. The candidates qualifying the skill test shall be recommended based on the merit decided by the Computer Based Test (CBT).”.

6. *Amendment of regulation 12.*— In regulation 12 of the principal Regulations,—

(i) in clause (2), for the expression “25% or two”, the expression “40% or “five” shall be substituted.

(ii) in clause (7), for the expression “up to 25% of the vacancies or two candidates”, the expression “up to 40% of the vacancies or five candidates” shall be substituted.
