Scheme for short listing of candidates for the Posts at Sl. No. 1, 7, 8, 10, 11, 17, 19, 20, 22 and 24:-

1. The Commission shall conduct common CBT I and CBT II for the post at Sl. No. **1, 7, 8, 10, 11, 17, 19, 20, 22 and 24**. The candidate has to apply for each post separately in the respective category i.e. UR, OBC, SC, ST, EWS, Ex-Servicemen, PWD, Meritorious Sportsperson etc. as the case may be to be considered for that post and in the respective category. The Candidate applying for more than one of the above posts has to appear in only one batch of CBT-I to be considered for all the above posts he/she has applied for. In case, the candidate appears for more than one batch of CBT I, his marks/score of the **first attempt/batch** shall be considered valid.
2. The CBT II of all the posts at Sl. No. **1, 7, 8, 10, 11, 17, 19, 20, 22 and 24** shall be common and will be held in one batch. After the final results, the candidates will be allowed to exercise the choice to opt for the post based on the eligibility as determined for the post and the merit of CBT II.
3. Amongst these, the candidates who have applied for the post of Aval Karkun or Treasurer Grade – III having minimum six months Diploma in Computer from a recognised Institution will be allowed to opt for the post of Aval Karkun or Treasurer Grade – III.
4. Amongst these, the candidates who have applied for the post of Store Keeper/ Godown Keeper having one year experience in handling stores and minimum six months certificate course in Computers will be allowed to opt for the post of Store Keeper/ Godown Keeper.
5. Amongst these, the candidates who have applied for the post of Accounts Clerk or Village Panchayat Secretary or Talathi having atleast one year working experience and minimum six months Diploma in Computer as per the recruitment rules will be

allowed to opt for the post of Accounts Clerk or Village Panchayat Secretary or Talathi.

6. Option once exercised shall be final and no further change shall be allowed.
7. The Commission shall thereafter, recommend the candidates for each of these posts, based on merit and the choice exercised by the candidate.

Scheme for short listing of candidates for the Posts from Sl. No. 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 21, and 25:

1. The Commission shall conduct common CBT I and CBT II for the post at Sl. No. **9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 21, and 25**. The candidate has to apply for each post separately in the respective category i.e. UR, OBC, SC, ST, EWS, Ex-Servicemen, PWD, Meritorious Sportsperson etc. as the case may be to be considered for that post and in the respective category. The Candidate applying for more than one of the above posts has to appear in only one batch of CBT-I to be considered for all the above posts he has applied for. In case, the candidate appears for more than one batch of CBT I, his marks/score of the **first attempt/batch** shall be considered valid.
2. The CBT II of all the posts at Sl. No. **9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 21, and 25** shall be common and will be held in one batch. After the final results, the candidates will be allowed to exercise the choice to opt for the post based on the eligibility as determined for the post and the merit of CBT II.
3. Option once exercised shall be final and no further change shall be allowed.
4. The Commission shall thereafter, recommend the candidates for each of these posts, based on merit and the choice exercised by the candidate.

Scheme for short listing of candidates for the Posts at Sl. No. 16 and 23:

1. The Commission shall conduct common CBT I and CBT II for the post at Sl. No. 16 and 23. The candidate has to apply for each post separately in the respective category i.e. UR, OBC, SC, ST, EWS, Ex-Servicemen, PWD, Meritorious Sportsperson etc. as the case may be to be considered for that post and in the respective category. The Candidate applying for more than one of the above posts has to appear in only one batch of CBT-I to be considered for all the above posts he has applied for. In case, the

candidate appears for more than one batch of CBT I, his marks/score of the **first attempt/batch** shall be considered valid.

2. The CBT II of all the posts at Sl. No. **16 and 23** shall be common and will be held in one batch. After the final results, the candidates will be allowed to exercise the choice to opt for the post based on the eligibility as determined for the post and the merit of CBT II.
3. Option once exercised shall be final and no further change shall be allowed.
4. The Commission shall thereafter, recommend the candidates for each of these posts, based on merit and the choice exercised by the candidate.

Scheme for short listing of candidates for the Posts at Sl. No. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 18:

1. The Commission will conduct Two Tier CBT for the posts at Sl. No. **2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 18** as per the scheme and syllabus published herein above.
2. Amongst these, the candidates who have applied for the post of Investigator having atleast one year working experience as per the recruitment rules will be allowed to opt for the post of Investigator.

Short listing ratio for CBT II and Common Instructions:

1. For the posts at Sl. No. 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 23, 25 the Commission will shortlist **fifteen times** the number of posts in each category/ sub-category for CBT II based on the merit of the CBT I.
2. For the posts at Sl. No. 4, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 24 the Commission will shortlist **ten times** the number of posts in each category/ sub-category for CBT II based on the merit of the CBT I.
3. The process of short listing for all the post is as per the detailed procedure available on the website under ‘ Standard Procedure of Short Listing the Candidate/s’
4. As per Regulation 15 of the Goa Staff Selection Commission (Examinations, Selection of Candidates to the sub-ordinate services/posts and procedure of conduct of the business of the Commission) Regulations, 2023, the placement of the candidates in different departments shall be based on the decision of the Commission. The Commission may follow the concept of proportionate representation depending on the

number of post/s in each department, number of departments forming part of recruitment process in each category with selected candidates arranged serially in descending order of merit. The decision of Commission shall be final. The Commission shall not entertain any request for change in allotment to Department from the candidate as well as from the Department.

This will be applicable to the posts where the nomenclature of the posts, level of the posts and the essential qualification of the posts as per the recruitment rules are common.
